My inspiration for creating EWL in 2004 was to give back the precious gift my parents gave me. Through a college education and the mentoring of my sweet Mother and other professional women throughout my career, I was able to re-invent my life and help women break the glass ceiling in the 1990s.

In 2019, EWL celebrated 15-years and our success of supporting over 100 women, giving \$250,000 in scholarships, and achieving a 94% success rate.
